

Teacher Notes: Kindness Map



Your Local Homelessness Charity

OBJECTIVE

This activity helps children understand how communities can support people in need and encourage thinking about ways to make a difference locally.

INSTRUCTIONS

1. Students draw a map of their school or local area or use the map below.
2. Ask them to mark places, people, or services that help others (e.g., food banks, libraries, shelters, neighbours).
3. Encourage students to add ideas for 'Kindness spots' where small actions can help people feel supported.
4. Discuss the importance of community support and what students can do to help others.

LEARNING OUTCOMES

- Raises awareness of community resources and support networks.
- Empathy and perspective-taking.
- Problem solving and creative thinking.

TOP TIPS:

- Remind students that kindness can be simple and doesn't have to be big gestures
- Make it interactive - students can walk around the school or local area to identify helpful places
